We cannot store perishable foods, but fresh produce can be received on a Wednesday or Friday morning for distribution on the same day (if received between 9.30am and 10.30am or by prior arrangement).		<u>Note:</u> although our clients are adults not children, we are regularly asked by parents if we have baby wipes / nappies / baby milk. We do not request donations of these items but can certainly receive & distribute them.

Donations of the above can be delivered to the J&P Refugee Project St Vincent's Centre (NE1 2TQ) on Mondays only, between 10:30am and 1:30pm, or otherwise by arrangement in advance with the Project Coordinator/Project Worker on 07407 091184.

Clothing and Household items (such as bedding, kitchenware etc.): We work collaboratively with the SVP at the St Vincent's Centre to distribute these items to our clients. Clothing can be donated at any time via the clothing bank in the SVP car park. Please check with the centre before delivering all other non-food or toiletry items as these are accepted depending on demand and storage capacity and only by arrangement with the SVP on 0191 261 6027.
