Gospel Acclamation

Gospel

Luke 23:35-43

'Lord, remember me when you come into your kingdom.'

At that time: The rulers scoffed at Jesus, saying, 'He saved others; let him save himself, if he is the Christ of God, his Chosen One!' The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine and saying, 'If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!' There was also an inscription over him, 'This is the King of the Jews.'

One of the criminals who were hanged there railed at Jesus, saying, 'Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!'

But the other rebuked him, saying, 'Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? And we indeed justly, for we are receiving the due reward of our deeds; but this man has done nothing wrong.'

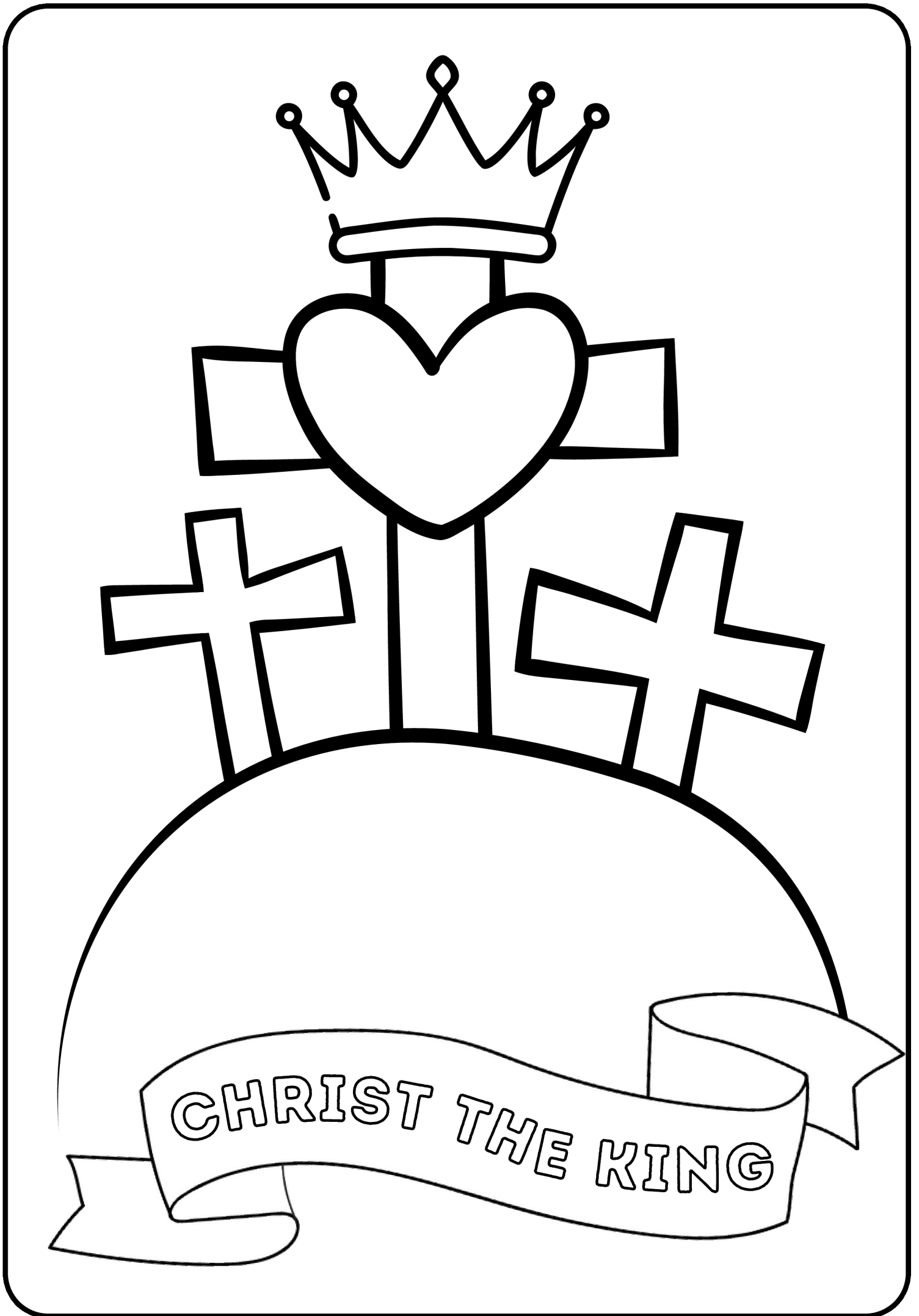
And he said, 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.' And he said to him, 'Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise.'

Gospel summary

When Jesus was on the Cross, some people did not believe he was the Son of God. Two men were on the crosses beside him. One was unkind to Jesus, but the other man was sorry for his mistakes, asking Jesus to remember him. Jesus smiled kindly and told him "Today you will be with me in heaven". From this Gospel, we are reminded that Jesus always forgives us when we are sorry.

What does this teach us today?



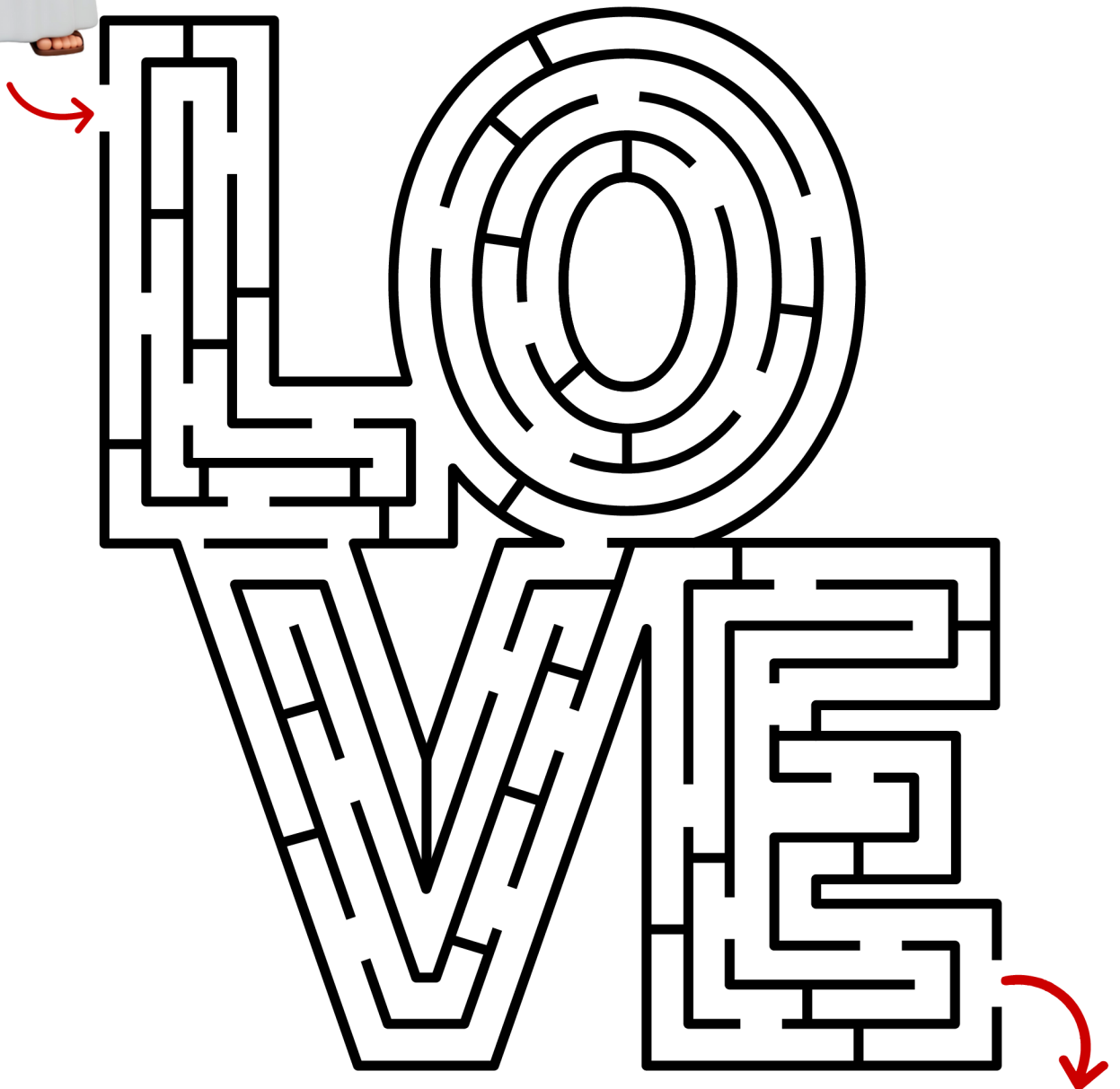


CHRIST THE KING
